Member Introductions	<i>Host Member & Coordinator</i>	Each member briefly introduces themselves, creating a warm and welcoming atmosphere
Main Sharing Session	<i>Host Parents, facilitated by Coordinator</i>	Parents share life stories, wisdom, family history, cultural heritage, or lessons from their journey
Fellowship Time	<i>All Members</i>	Relaxed time together – stroll in the garden/compound, enjoy surroundings, or continue conversations in small groups
Shared Lunch	<i>Host Family + Group Support</i>	Enjoy a hearty meal together, sharing stories and laughter around the table
Optional Activities	<i>Led by Coordinator</i>	View family photos/videos, light garden help, traditional games, or quiet rest. Flexible to natural flow
